• Meeting was opened at 6:35PM by Treasurer, Greg Mauro

Secretary's Report

o The minutes from the last meeting (July) were approved as published on the Google groups reflector

Treasurer's Report – Greg Mauro

o September balance: \$4000. August Income: dues, \$375; misc: \$25. August Expenses: balance of roof loan from 2017, \$1000; monthly electric bill, \$153

o Current membership: 11 new members this month, total is now 98 members

§ The treasurer's report was approved as read.

Station Director – Dom DiClementi

o The Open House held in August at the radio shack was well attended. 10 new members joined. A mention of appreciation was given to all of the members who volunteered and made the event successful

o The south tower beam was repaired and is operational

o A reminder was given to all users of the shack that the cypher lock has been found to be disengaged multiple times. The cypher lock should not be disengaged at any time.

o All three stations are fully operational

o The NJ QSO party will be held this coming weekend. Operators are needed at the shack and needed to operate from home.

Repeater Report

o The 2 meter repeater (146.67, PL131.8) was replaced in July with a new System Fusion machine. As a reminder the repeater now operates in AMS mode. Functionally, the repeater operates in FM analog mode if the input signal is FM analog; and operates in digital (Fusion, C4FM protocol) mode if the input signal is digital. Analog only users are encouraged to use tone squelch on receive to avoid the digital "noise" when the repeater is in digital mode. Digital users are requested to avoid using digital mode during the period of the nightly analog net at 10PM.

§ The repeater hosts the "Pepper" net - a nightly net at 10PM in the analog mode.

o The UHF (442.650) Fusion (only) repeater is slated to be upgraded to the new System Fusion machine in the near future. Operation will be identical after the upgrade.

Physical Plant Director – Hy Gold

o A work party is tentatively scheduled for Saturday, October 13<sup>th</sup> to perform minor maintenance items. A notice will be posted on the Google groups reflector.

o Help is needed with lawn maintenance through the end of the growing season. The weekly task involves operating the tractor to cut the grass and weed whacking. Contact Hy to volunteer and receive instruction on operating the equipment, if needed.

o A brief discussion was held on a proposal to install a porta potty at the site. This was tabled and will be discussed in greater detail at the monthly operations meeting.
